

Bokashi Troubleshooting Quick Reference Guide

<i>Problem</i>	<i>Solution</i>
<i>Foul Odors</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Drain Liquid regularly.- Use adequate Bokashi Bran.- Aerate the pre-compost.
<i>Slow Fermentation</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Chop food waste finely.- Maintain balanced layering.- Properly seal the Bokashi bin.
<i>Mold Growth on Pre-Compost</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Use fresh Bokashi Bran.- Reduce moisture by adding more bran and draining excess liquid.- Check for spoiled food scraps.
<i>Bokashi Tea Odors</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Aerate and drain the Bokashi bin.- Use a Bokashi Tea Strainer.- Dilute and apply Bokashi tea promptly.
<i>Excessive Moisture</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Add dry materials like shredded newspaper, sawdust, or dry leaves.- Drain liquid regularly.- Layer food waste and bran properly.
<i>Unfermented Food Scraps</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Chop food scraps finely.- Mix thoroughly when layering.- Consider using a bit more Bokashi bran.
<i>White Bugs (Mites)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Avoid overfeeding the bin.- Increase the amount of Bokashi bran.- Ensure proper aeration by mixing the pre-compost well.
