Bokashi Troubleshooting Quick Reference Guide

Problem	Solution
Foul Odors	Drain Liquid regularly.Use adequate Bokashi Bran.Aerate the pre-compost.
Slow Fermentation	Chop food waste finely.Maintain balanced layering.Properly seal the Bokashi bin.
Mold Growth on Pre-Compost	 Use fresh Bokashi Bran. Reduce moisture by adding more bran and draining excess liquid. Check for spoiled food scraps.
Bokashi Tea Odors	- Aerate and drain the Bokashi bin.- Use a Bokashi Tea Strainer.- Dilute and apply Bokashi tea promptly.
Excessive Moisture	Add dry materials like shredded newspaper, sawdust, or dry leaves.Drain liquid regularly.Layer food waste and bran properly.
Unfermented Food Scraps	Chop food scraps finely.Mix thoroughly when layering.Consider using a bit more Bokashi bran.
White Bugs (Mites)	 Avoid overfeeding the bin. Increase the amount of Bokashi bran. Ensure proper aeration by mixing the pre-compost well.
