



Practicum Student Program

Practicum Students will learn about organic, holistic, and integrated farming methods while contributing to the farm through hands-on learning and collaborative development. Workshops, guest lectures, field trips and coursework on sustainable agricultural development will be offered to adults who demonstrate interest and potential.

In 2015 we will be offering three 3-month terms beginning in March, June, and September. After completion of their first term, students are encouraged to apply for additional terms as Capstone Students with a more focused individual project. Tuition is \$2,000 per 3-month term and scholarships are available. Students may choose to live on or off site- Room and Board fee is \$1,000 per 3-month term.
