

## Land Manager in Southern Oregon

We are looking for a long-term land manager – six months to a year (longer also possible). This person will ideally: be permaculture minded, have an interest in alternative building, enjoy hard work, have some skills in small construction, willing to be flexible with timing & projects, and able to think creatively about off-grid-living. Lodging, food, stipend, etc... are available.

The property is 20 acres off grid (and next to BLM land) outside of Roseburg, Oregon. It is located in a one-of-a-kind valley that has about 35 all off-grid homesteads in it (all super friendly folks).



We travel a lot, and we are starting to plan to be away for a season. The Land Manager would be able to help with current projects and to manage the property while we are gone.

The property has two cabin-areas on it already - one on each side of the stream (we are in one, friends are in the other). We have lots of projects going on at all times (everything from cob buildings to micro hydro/solar systems to road work to yurt structures to soccer pitch to music studio to chickens to barn/wood-working area etc...).
